

First attendances, 2006-07

For the 2006-07 financial year, Hospital Episode Statistics (HES) has collected more than 60 million records detailing outpatient appointments, delivered by NHS hospitals in England or performed in the Independent sector, commissioned by English NHS.

The latest HES data are available via the internet from the Freely available data section of the HESonline website [www.hesonline.nhs.uk]. Please note that in order to avoid undue delay in the publication of these tables; the counts have not been adjusted to account for shortfalls in the number of records received from NHS trusts, or for missing/invalid clinical data (ie diagnosis and operation codes) – hence the label 'Ungrossed data' in each table.

You must exercise great care when comparing HES figures for different years. Fluctuations in the data can occur for a number of reasons, e.g. organisational changes, reviews of best practice within the medical community, the adoption of new coding schemes and data quality problems that are often year specific. These variations can lead to false assumptions about trends. We advise users of time series data to carefully explore the relevant issues before drawing any conclusions about the reasons for year-on-year changes.

Data quality

The HES database is assembled from records originally generated by the patient administration systems within more than five hundred separate NHS trusts. While the HES team liaise closely with the NHS in order to maintain data quality and consistency, it is inevitable in such a complex undertaking that a few errors will occur.

Detailed NHS Trust DQI Reports are available on the HESonline website [www.hesonline.nhs.uk/Ease/servlet/ContentServer?siteID=1937&categoryID=452]. The reports comprise both component and qualifier scores, including counts of the HES records and the data items examined.

Users of the data who discover apparent anomalies should feel free to contact the HES team, so that they may investigate.

First attendances

Data in this table are for those who attended a *first* outpatient appointment only. This is also split by main specialty and age groups.

Table column definitions

This section contains descriptions of the column headers found in the free data tables that you can download from the HESonline website.

Age 0-9

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were up to 9 years of age (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 10-19

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 10 and 19 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 20-29

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 20 and 29 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 30-39

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 30 and 39 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 40-49

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 40 and 49 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 50-59

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 50 and 59 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 60-69

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 60 and 69 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 70-79

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 70 and 79 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 80-89

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 80 and 89 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 90+

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were 90 years of age or older when the attendance occurred.

Unknown age

The date of birth of the patient is invalid or unknown; therefore their age group is unknown.

All ages

The number of all attendances relating to patients of any age.
