



Main specialty by age and sex for first outpatient attendances, 2007-08

For the 2007-08 financial year, Hospital Episode Statistics (HES) has collected more than 60 million records detailing outpatient appointments delivered by NHS hospitals in England or performed in the independent sector, and commissioned by the English NHS.

Outpatient Hospital Episode Statistics (HES) data was collected for the first time in 2003-04. The NHS Information Centre first released outpatient data at the end of July 2006 and the data was originally released on an 'experimental' basis. Since then, the experimental label has been removed and in 2008 the outpatients published tables were accredited as a National Statistic. This means the data within these specific tables has been produced in accordance with the 'Code of Practice for Official Statistics'.

The outpatients' data set contains individual records for all outpatient appointments occurring in England such as the type of attendance ie whether it was a first or follow up attendance or the source of referral ie whether or not the outpatient appointment was initiated by the consultant responsible for the outpatient attendance or not.

Please note that in order to avoid undue delay in the publication of these tables, the counts have not been adjusted to account for shortfalls in the number of records received from NHS trusts or for missing/ invalid clinical data (ie diagnosis and operation codes).

Great care must be exercised when comparing HES figures for different years. Fluctuations in the data can occur for a number of reasons, eg organisational changes, reviews of best practice within the medical community, the adoption of new coding schemes and data quality problems that are often year specific. These variations can lead to false assumptions about trends. We advise users of time series data to carefully explore the relevant issues before drawing any conclusions about the reasons for year-on-year changes.

Coverage and data quality

Hospital Episode Statistics (HES) are compiled from data sent by almost 400 NHS trusts and primary care trusts (PCTs) in England. Data is also received from a number of independent sector organisations for activity commissioned by the English NHS. The NHS Information Centre for health and social care liaises closely with these organisations to encourage submission of complete and valid data, and seeks to minimise inaccuracies and the effect of missing and invalid data via HES processes. While this brings about improvement over time, some shortcomings remain.

A Data Quality Dashboard is available on the Connecting for Health website [http://nww.connectingforhealth.nhs.uk/reporting-services/data-quality]. The Data Quality Dashboard is a national resource to support improvement and completeness of all Commissioning Data Set (CDS) data flows to the Secondary Uses Service (SUS), including the Outpatient CDS. The Dashboard can be used by organisations to review the data they've submitted to SUS and to ensure that the data is comprehensive, compliant with data standards, complete and accurate.

It is not mandatory for providers to code procedures and diagnoses on outpatient records and therefore the coverage is low. The poor coverage may in part be accounted for by the fact that there may be no appropriate OPCS-4 code available, or that the cause of morbidity was unknown. In 2007-08 around 2% of records had a known cause of morbidity and 3% of records had completed or appropriate OPCS-4 codes. However, it is not clear how representative the figures are as we have no reliable existing data source to validate the data against; Department of Health aggregate returns have never collected clinical codes. Known provider issues

Clatterbridge Centre for Oncology NHS Foundation Trust (REN) and Wrightington, Wigan and Leigh NHS Trust (RRF) were unable to submit complete 2007-08 outpatient data, which may account for shortfalls in the data. Data from these trusts should therefore be interpreted with caution. A data quality flag has been used to highlight this data (in grey shading) in the hospital provider table.

Users of the data who discover apparent anomalies should feel free to contact the HES team, so that they may investigate.

First attendances

Data in this table are for those who attended a first outpatient appointment. This is also split by main specialty, sex and age groups.

Table column definitions

This section contains descriptions of the column headers found in the freely available outpatient publication tables that can be downloaded from the HESonline website.

Main specialty

Main specialty reflects the specialty under which the consultant with prime responsibility for the patient is registered. The main specialties, recognised by the Royal Colleges and Faculties, reflect broad ranges of skills and expertise, and provide a quick summary of areas of treatment. The specialty codes consist of three numbers and are followed by a description.

Age 0-9

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were up to 9 years of age (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 10-19

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 10 and 19 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 20-29

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 20 and 29 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 30-39

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 30 and 39 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 40-49

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 40 and 49 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 50-59

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 50 and 59 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 60-69

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 60 and 69 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 70-79

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 70 and 79 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 80-89

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were between the ages of 80 and 89 years (inclusive) when the attendance occurred.

Age 90+

The number of all attendances relating to patients who were 90 years of age or older when the attendance occurred.

Unknown age

The date of birth of the patient is invalid or unknown; therefore their age group is unknown.

Total (All ages)

The number of all attendances relating to patients of any age.
